
Map 2 FIRST CONNECTICUT LAKE

Located north of Pittsburg, New Hampshire off Route 3.

Recreation

First Connecticut Lake is a large open lake with excellent fishing and boating. There are picnic areas on the island in the lake and off Route 3 north of the dam.

Natural Features

The Connecticut Lakes and the Connecticut River in this region are home to some of the most premier fishing New Hampshire has to offer, and the surrounding lands are host to numerous trails and other outdoor activities that attract visitors from far and wide.

History

The lake was developed to accumulate logs for log drives down the Connecticut River.

Safety

- Daytime use only—camping not allowed.
- PFDs required by Coast Guard regulations.
- Grill fires are allowed in designated picnic areas if fire danger is low.
- All-terrain vehicles and trail bikes are not allowed on any trails or property.
- Fishermen, hunters and trappers must carry appropriate state licenses and permits.
- River flows fluctuate seasonally, daily and sometimes hourly.
- Water levels may change rapidly in the rivers—especially near dams.
